








"Libraries and meeting rooms are inserted into the acute corners of the building geometry. The new timber podium brings the staff even closer to the surrounding city."




















"Wood, carpet, textiles – ideal acoustics and a warm color scheme. A flexible modular system comprised of working clusters, creative cubicles, and wardrobes."







"The load bearing core is cladded with wooden fins, growing like a vital tree trunk through all floors of the building, as a reflection of the corporate identity of Wien Energie."
